Workers of the world, unite!

To effectively defend against the internal policies of the Meloni government it is also necessary to oppose its international policy

The Meloni government's attack proceeds with the measures contained in the new budget law, with those being prepared in the "collegato lavoro", with the "differentiated autonomy law" and with the so-called "security package". These are measures that aim to hit the entire working class at 360 degrees: on the economic, regulatory, trade union and political levels. These are measures that, among other things, **aim to accentuate the divisions** between workers (by region, skin color, age and gender) in order to weaken their general capacity for resistance and mobilization. But the government's anti-proletarian action is also expressed **on the international level**. The Meloni government is fully involved in participating:

- to the **aggression** that, through Ukraine, the **US-EU-NATO** have been carrying out for at least ten years **against the Russian and Russian-speaking working populations of Donbass**, with the intention of bending Russia and hitting the rise of Chinese capitalism, in order to plunder the immense resources of those territories and appropriate the arms of millions of workers from Eastern Europe and Asia.
- To the decades-long war of extermination waged by Israel against the indomitable Palestinian people and against the working masses of the Middle East, not only on its own behalf, but also on behalf of the USA, the EU and the entire West.

These neocolonial wars are also directed **against the workers in Italy and in the West**: they aim to drag them into a spiral of war with the proletarians of the South of the world, for now on the political level, sooner or later also as cannon fodder on the battlefields. The proletarians of the West, on the contrary, have every interest in rejecting this suicidal prospect and in **supporting unconditionally**, and regardless of the political leaderships on which it is currently based, the **resistance** of these exploited, working masses, also as a factor in the weakening of the governments of "our home". The policies of the Meloni government are in fact an integral part of an offensive that marches internationally. Thinking that you can defend yourself by entrenching yourself in "your own" company or in "your own" territory would simply be illusory and losing. We need to look beyond our immediate "borders" and start thinking about how to build political, debate and organizational ties **beyond corporate**, **national**, **skin color and gender fences**.

Working to bring these vital issues to life in the general strike of November 29 and after wards, is a "small" but important step.
